

# Manheim Township Boys Travel Basketball Tryouts

The Manheim Township Travel Basketball Association will be holding tryouts for interested 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade boys. Players are expected to attend both tryout sessions. Please complete the registration form on the back of this page and bring it to the first tryout sessions. **Please note:** Parents and spectators are asked to remain outside the gym during the tryouts. The evaluators will consist of former program coaches and Board members. No parent of any player trying out for the team will be part of the selection process. *It should also be noted that 4<sup>th</sup> graders will be given the opportunity to tryout, but preference will be given to 5<sup>th</sup> graders if the skill sets are equal.* The schedule is as follows:

## **Manheim Township Travel Basketball Association (MTTBA)**
